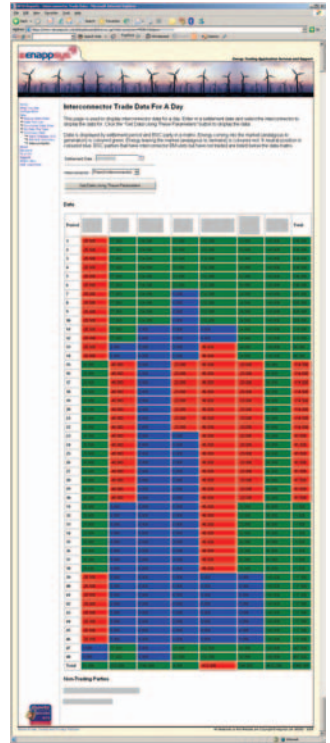

Because the data is displayed in a standard web browser there is no complicated software to install on the user's computer. You can view the data from anywhere with an internet connection.

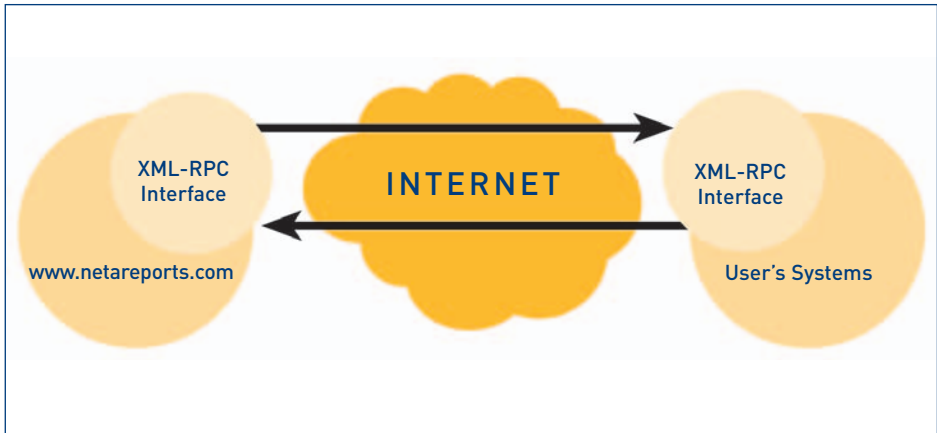

**www.netareports.com** displays data as web pages, in MS Excel™ spreadsheets and via a web-services interface.

The web-services interface (called XML-RPC) allows the user to integrate the data directly into their own business systems.



You can use the service as the base of your own decision support systems.
